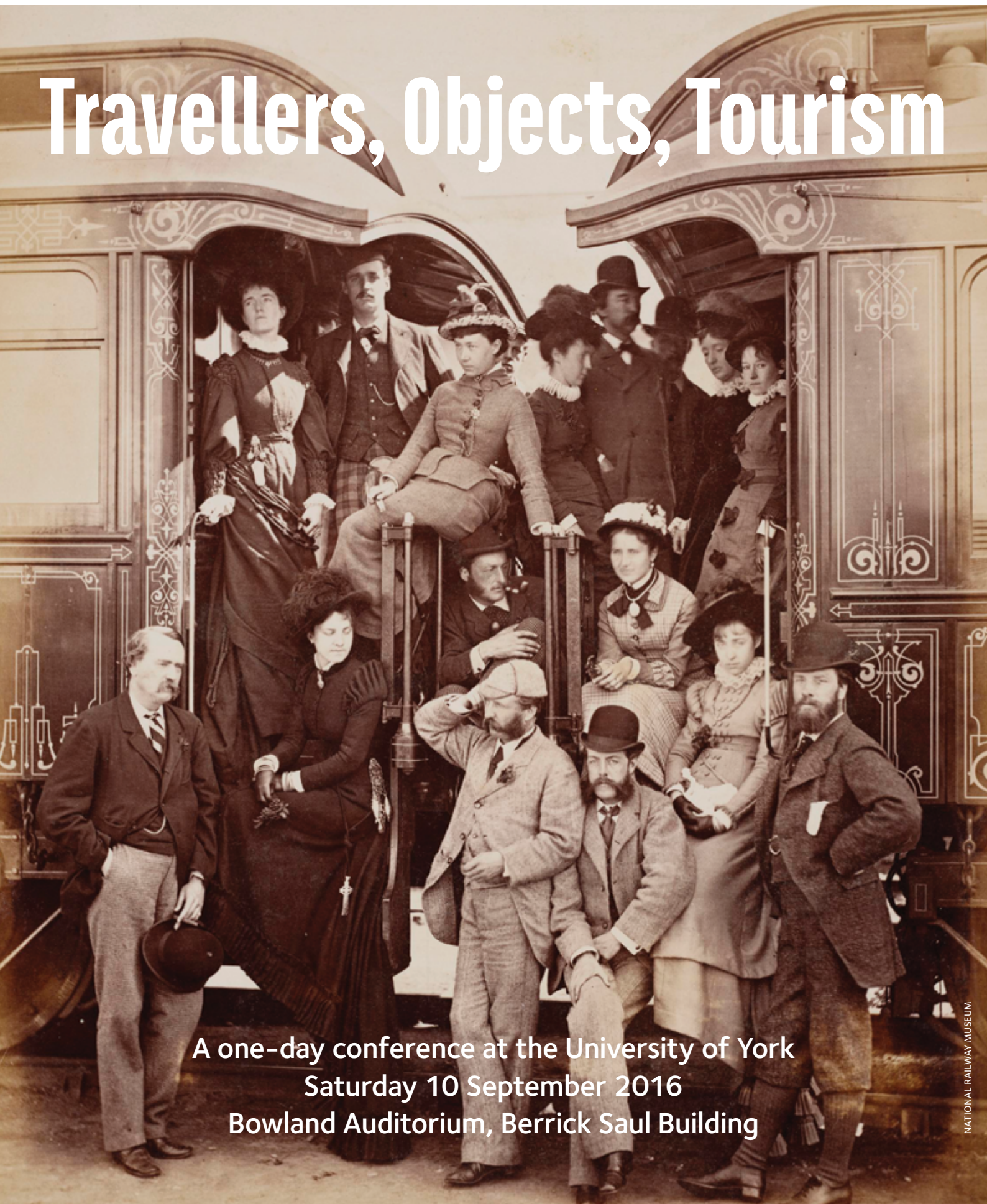


# Travellers, Objects, Tourism
